ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT

Washington D.C., Maryland and Virginia are some of the best states for women-owned businesses. Washington, D.C., and Maryland rank 1 and 3 respectively for the number of businesses owned by women. While all three of the states are in the top 10 for the amount of sales and employment from women-owned businesses.



INNOVATION CORRIDOR

Region 3 claims a vibrant technology sector. Virginia had the second highest concentration of tech workers in the nation in 2014, with over 8% employed in tech industries.



ECONOMIC GROWTH

Maryland small businesses make up 97.4% of all employers and employ over half of the state's workforce. Region 3 ranks first in high-tech businesses as a share of all small business establishments (5.2%) and employment in high tech businesses as a share of all small employment (6.1%).
