

## **Economic Output and Employment**

Figure 1: Employment by Establishment Size (Employees)



- The American Samoa economy contracted at an annual rate of 5.3% to \$598.0 million in 2017 while per capita income decreased 5.5% to \$10,187 in 2017. (Source: BEA)
- The number of private sector employees in American Samoa increased 4.3% to 8,506 in 2016. (Source: CBP)
- · Figure 1 displays private sector employment for establishments with fewer than 500 employees from 2008 to 2016. Establishments with fewer than 100 employees have the largest share of overall employment. (Source:

## **International Trade**

- Figure 2 displays the evolution of American Samoa imports, exports, and trade balance from 2002 to 2017. (Source: BEA)
- In 2017, American Samoa total exports decreased 21.1% 500M to \$358.0 million, while its total imports decreased 12.9% to \$486.0 million. This resulted in a 2017 trade deficit of \$128.0 million. (Source: BEA)
- \* Exports and imports reflect trade between American Samoa and the rest of the world, including the US.

Economic growth and trade statistics are expressed in real US dollars. Values labeled 's' in Table 1 were withheld by the Census Bureau -500M because they do not meet publication standards or could disclose information regarding individual businesses.

Figure 2: Exports and Imports (\$)






Figure 3: American Samoa Employment by Municipality, 2016. (Source: CBP)
