

### **Business dynamics**


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2019 and March 2020, 18,512 Arizona establishments opened and 16,531 closed, for a net increase of 1,981. Employment expanded at 33,638 and contracted at 31,788. Small businesses accounted for 18,326 openings and 16,295 closings.


#### **Employment**

Opening and expanding Arizona establishments added 285,955 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 227,613, for a net increase of 58,342 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 42,360 jobs, or 72.6 percent of that total.

#### Thousands of jobs





#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2019, reporting banks issued \$1.5 billion in loans to Arizona businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$2.1 billion, and total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$4.3 billion.



#### **Small business exports**

A total of 7,848 identified firms exported goods worth \$23.2 billion from Arizona in 2019. Of those exporters, 6,812—or 86.8 percent—were small. Small firms exported goods worth \$5.6 billion, making up 24.0 percent of exports by identified firms.




