

## Share of employees working at small businesses by county



## **Business dynamics**

#### **Establishments**

Between March 2019 and March 2020, 9,867 Oklahoma establishments opened and 9,889 closed, for a net decrease of 22. Employment expanded at 21,304 and contracted at 22,951. Small businesses accounted for 9,717 openings and 9,807 closings.


## Thousands of establishments



### **Employment**

Opening and expanding Oklahoma establishments added 141,366 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 155,133, for a net decrease of 13,767 jobs. Small businesses gained 120,635 jobs and lost 136,512, for a net decrease of 15,877 jobs.

#### Thousands of jobs



#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2019, reporting banks issued \$1.1 billion in loans to Oklahoma businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$905.3 million, and total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$2.5 billion.



### **Small business exports**

A total of 3,162 identified firms exported goods worth \$5.6 billion from Oklahoma in 2019. Of those exporters, 2,629—or 83.1 percent—were small. Small firms exported goods worth \$1.8 billion, making up 31.7 percent of exports by identified firms.


