




Between March 2019 and March 2020, 2,040 Vermont establishments opened and 2,287 closed, for a net decrease of 247. Employment expanded at 4,632 and contracted at 5,133. Small businesses accounted for 4,534 expansions and 5,030 contractions.

Opening and expanding Vermont establishments added 19,459 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 24,278, for a net decrease of 4,819 jobs. Small business expansions added 13,103 jobs, while small business contractions lost 15,171.

#### Thousands of jobs





### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2019, reporting banks issued \$170.8 million in loans to Vermont businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$172.7 million, and total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$468.3 million.



### **Small business exports**

A total of 1,103 identified firms exported goods worth \$2.9 billion from Vermont in 2019. Of those exporters, 951—or 86.2 percent—were small. Small firms exported goods worth \$515.0 million, making up 18.0 percent of exports by identified firms.

Racial minorities made up 4.9 percent of workers and owned 2.4 percent of businesses.


