

Share of employees working at small businesses by county



Business dynamics

Establishments

Between March 2019 and March 2020, 3,444 West Virginia establishments opened and 3,939 closed, for a net decrease of 495. Employment expanded at 9,275 and contracted at 10,566. Small businesses accounted for 3,405 openings and 3,875 closings.



Employment

Opening and expanding West Virginia establishments added 51,745 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 66,579, for a net decrease of 14,834 jobs. Small businesses gained 46,500 jobs and lost 58,573, for a net decrease of 12,073 jobs.






Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2019, reporting banks issued \$340.8 million in loans to West Virginia businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$298.6 million, and total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$967.0 million.



Small business exports

A total of 1,054 identified firms exported goods worth \$5.4 billion from West Virginia in 2019. Of those exporters, 816—or 77.4 percent—were small. Small firms exported goods worth \$1.6 billion, making up 28.9 percent of exports by identified firms.




