

# **Business dynamics**


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2019 and March 2020, 2,493 Wyoming establishments opened and 2,410 closed, for a net increase of 83. Employment expanded at 5,102 and contracted at 5,180. Small businesses accounted for 5,054 expansions and 5,154 contractions.


#### **Employment**

Opening and expanding Wyoming establishments added 24,027 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 25,618, for a net decrease of 1,591 jobs. Small business expansions added 15,353 jobs, while small business contractions lost 17,117.

#### Thousands of jobs





#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2019, reporting banks issued \$194.1 million in loans to Wyoming businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$208.5 million, and total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$449.7 million.



## **Small business exports**

A total of 477 identified firms exported goods worth \$1.3 billion from Wyoming in 2019. Of those exporters, 375—or 78.6 percent—were small. Small firms exported goods worth \$872.0 million, making up 68.7 percent of exports by identified firms.




