


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 2,198 Alaska establishments opened and 1,646 closed, for a net increase of 552. Employment expanded at 4,276 establishments and contracted at 5,276. Small businesses accounted for 2,096 establishment openings and 1,534 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Alaska establishments added 21,723 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 36,517, for a net decrease of 14,794 jobs. Small businesses gained 18,185 jobs and lost 25,880, for a net decrease of 7,695 jobs.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$321.9 million in loans to Alaska businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 705 identified firms exported goods worth \$4.3 billion from Alaska in 2020. Of those exporters, 498—or 70.6 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$1.7 billion, making up 39.9 percent of exports by identified firms.


