




Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 39,234 Georgia establishments opened and 29,153 closed, for a net increase of 10,081. Employment expanded at 53,917 establishments and contracted at 63,078. Small businesses accounted for 36,829 openings and 26,517 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Georgia establishments added 452,061 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 540,968, for a net decrease of 88,907 jobs. Small businesses gained 305,805 jobs and lost 330,039, for a net decrease of 24,234 jobs.





Thousands of jobs





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$3.7 billion in loans to Georgia businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$4.4 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$13.0 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 14,048 identified firms exported goods worth \$36.3 billion from Georgia in 2020. Of those exporters, 12,288—or 87.5 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$11.5 billion, making up 31.7 percent of exports by identified firms.


