


Establishments


Between March 2020 and March 2021, 39,354 Illinois establishments opened and 31,400 closed, for a net increase of 7,954. Employment expanded at 59,543 establishments and contracted at 80,019. Small businesses accounted for 38,231 openings and 29,458 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Illinois establishments added 445,975 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 705,518, for a net decrease of 259,543 jobs. Small businesses gained 307,975 jobs and lost 452,955, for a net decrease of 144,980 jobs.

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$4.4 billion in loans to Illinois businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

A total of 21,836 identified firms exported goods worth \$49.7 billion from Illinois in 2020. Of those exporters, 19,445—or 89.1 percent—were small. 
