

#### **Establishments**


Between March 2020 and March 2021, 6,515 New Hampshire establishments opened and 4,837 closed, for a net increase of 1,678. Employment expanded at 10,003 establishments and contracted at 12,427. Small businesses accounted for 5,978 openings and 4,404 closings.

#### Employment

Opening and expanding New Hampshire establishments added 53,392 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 73,763, for a net decrease of 20,371 jobs. Small businesses gained 40,054 jobs and lost 52,695, for a net decrease of 12,641 jobs.



#### Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$421.2 million in loans to New Hampshire businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$605.6 million. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$1.8 billion. 

#### Small business exports

A total of 2,477 identified firms exported goods worth \$5.3 billion from New Hampshire in 2020. Of those exporters, 2,126—or 85.8 percent—were small. 
