

# **Business dynamics**


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 15,709 South Carolina establishments opened and 11,924 closed, for a net increase of 3,785. Employment expanded at 26,641 establishments and contracted at 30,769. Small businesses accounted for 14,969 openings and 11,133 closings.


#### **Employment**

Opening and expanding South Carolina establishments added 190,134 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 226,231, for a net decrease of 36,097 jobs. Small businesses gained 129,080 jobs and lost 144,840, for a net decrease of 15,760 jobs.

#### Thousands of establishments




#### Thousands of jobs

#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$1.7 billion in loans to South Carolina businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

### **Small business exports**

A total of 6,246 identified firms exported goods worth \$27.8 billion from South Carolina in 2020. Of those exporters, 5,259—or 84.2 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$2.8 billion, making up 10.0 percent of exports by identified firms.


