

#### **Business dynamics**


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 4,633 West Virginia establishments opened and 4,329 closed, for a net increase of 304. Employment expanded at 8,826 establishments and contracted at 11,443. Small businesses accounted for 4,274 openings and 3,836 closings.


#### **Employment**

Opening and expanding West Virginia establishments added 55,852 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 75,307, for a net decrease of 19,455 jobs. Small businesses gained 40,726 jobs and lost 53,963, for a net decrease of 13,237 jobs.

#### Thousands of jobs



#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$391.3 million in loans to West Virginia businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$443.8 million. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$1.6 billion.



## **Small business exports**

A total of 1,017 identified firms exported goods worth \$4.2 billion from West Virginia in 2020. Of those exporters, 785—or 77.2 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$1.3 billion, making up 30.8 percent of exports by identified firms.




