




Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 2,800 Wyoming establishments opened and 2,343 closed, for a net increase of 457. Employment expanded at 5,045 establishments and contracted at 5,564. Small businesses accounted for 2,599 establishment openings and 2,144 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Wyoming establishments added 21,999 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 32,212, for a net decrease of 10,213 jobs. Small businesses gained 17,930 jobs and lost 24,353, for a net decrease of 6,423 jobs.






Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$251.4 million in loans to Wyoming businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 485 identified firms exported goods worth \$1.1 billion from Wyoming in 2020. Of those exporters, 384—or 79.2 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$762.0 million, making up 68.6 percent of exports by identified firms.


