


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 11,043 Arkansas establishments opened and 8,020 closed, for a net increase of 3,023. Employment expanded at 19,606 establishments and contracted at 15,732. Small businesses accounted for 10,357 openings and 7,633 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Arkansas establishments added 127,601 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 89,431, for a net increase of 38,170 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 25,937 jobs, or 68.0 percent of that total.

Thousands of jobs





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$1.3 billion in loans to Arkansas businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.0 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$3.2 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 2,217 identified firms exported goods worth \$4.9 billion from Arkansas in 2021. Of those exporters, 1,715—or 77.4 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$1.2 billion, making up 23.7 percent of exports by identified firms.


