




Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 16,510 Connecticut establishments opened and 10,245 closed, for a net increase of 6,265. Employment expanded at 28,454 establishments and contracted at 20,505. Small businesses accounted for 15,892 openings and 9,598 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Connecticut establishments added 177,682 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 113,942, for a net increase of 63,740 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 54,373 jobs, or 85.3 percent of that total.







Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$1.2 billion in loans to Connecticut businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.7 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$4.5 billion.


Small business exports

A total of 5,475 identified firms exported goods worth \$13.7 billion from Connecticut in 2021. Of those exporters, 4,833—or 88.3 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$6.2 billion, making up 45.6 percent of exports by identified firms.


