


Business dynamics


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 18,730 Nevada establishments opened and 8,336 closed, for a net increase of 10,394. Employment expanded at 24,484 establishments and contracted at 16,663. Small businesses accounted for 18,296 openings and 8,012 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Nevada establishments added 247,461 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 97,667, for a net increase of 149,794 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 90,803 jobs, or 60.6 percent of that total.





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$715.1 million in loans to Nevada businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.2 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$2.7 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 3,362 identified firms exported goods worth \$8.5 billion from Nevada in 2021. Of those exporters, 2,868—or 85.3 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$2.9 billion, making up 34.5 percent of exports by identified firms.


