


# **Business dynamics**


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 26,702 Tennessee establishments opened and 15,211 closed, for a net increase of 11,491. Employment expanded at 47,772 establishments and contracted at 35,954. Small businesses accounted for 25,753 openings and 14,543 closings.

# **Employment**

Opening and expanding Tennessee establishments added 366,480 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 226,069, for a net increase of 140,411 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 100,929 jobs, or 71.9 percent of that total.







#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$2.4 billion in loans to Tennessee businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$2.1 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$7.0 billion.



# **Small business exports**

A total of 7,282 identified firms exported goods worth \$32.6 billion from Tennessee in 2021. Of those exporters, 6,009—or 82.5 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$5.6 billion, making up 17.3 percent of exports by identified firms.


