


#### **Establishments**

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 11,978 Arkansas establishments opened and 7,858 closed, for a net increase of 4,120. Employment expanded at 20,041 establishments and contracted at 16,042. Small businesses accounted for 11,136 openings and 7,287 closings.


#### **Employment**

Opening and expanding Arkansas establishments added 127,517 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 92,173, for a net increase of 35,344 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 31,014 jobs, or 87.7 percent of that total.

Counts include temporary closures and reopenings.



#### **Small business loans**

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$1.2 billion in loans to Arkansas businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$886.2 million. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$2.7 billion.



#### **Small business exports**

A total of 2,190 identified firms exported goods worth \$5.3 billion from Arkansas in 2022. Of those exporters, 1,665—or 76.0 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$1.2 billion, making up 22.9 percent of exports by identified firms.


