


Establishments

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 18,894 Oregon establishments opened and 18,030 closed, for a net increase of 864. Employment expanded at 34,144 establishments and contracted at 31,306. Small businesses accounted for 17,939 openings and for 17,171 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Oregon establishments added 198,074 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 176,549, for a net increase of 21,525 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 17,796 jobs, or 82.7 percent of that total.

Thousands of jobs





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$930.4 million in loans to Oregon businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.2 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$2.8 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 5,530 identified firms exported goods worth \$33.6 billion from Oregon in 2022. Of those exporters, 4,836—or 87.5 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$6.9 billion, making up 20.4 percent of exports by identified firms.


