


Employer and employment dynamics


Establishments

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 35,984 Pennsylvania establishments opened and 32,986 closed, for a net increase of 2,998. Employment expanded at 89,715 establishments and contracted at 75,121. Small businesses accounted for 34,351 openings and 31,423 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Pennsylvania establishments added 531,150 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 422,571, for a net increase of 108,579 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 89,756 jobs, or 82.7 percent of that total.



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Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$3.3 billion in loans to Pennsylvania businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 15,718 identified firms exported goods worth \$46.1 billion from Pennsylvania in 2022. Of those exporters, 13,812—or 87.9 percent—were small. 
