


# **Employer and employment dynamics**

#### **Establishments**

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 25,773 Tennessee establishments opened and 18,550 closed, for a net increase of 7,223. Employment expanded at 48,496 establishments and contracted at 38,559. Small businesses accounted for 24,677 openings and 17,627 closings.

#### Employment

Opening and expanding Tennessee establishments added 341,945 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 266,121, for a net increase of 75,824 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 72,477 jobs, or 95.6 percent of that total.



# Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$2.2 billion in loans to Tennessee businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 


# Small business exports

A total of 7,268 identified firms exported goods worth \$35.8 billion from Tennessee in 2022. Of those exporters, 5,981—or 82.3 percent—were small. 
