


Employer and employment dynamics

Establishments

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 94,821 Texas establishments opened and 74,270 closed, for a net increase of 20,551. Employment expanded at 185,776 establishments and contracted at 148,680. Small businesses accounted for 87,638 openings and 68,285 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Texas establishments added 1.6 million jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 1.1 million, for a net increase of 520,610 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 386,267 jobs, or 74.2 percent of that total. Thousands of establishments



Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$9.3 billion in loans to Texas businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

A total of 40,451 identified firms exported goods worth \$442.7 billion from Texas in 2022. Of those exporters, 37,305—or 92.2 percent—were small. 
