




Establishments

Between March 2022 and March 2023, 5,903 West Virginia establishments opened and 4,612 closed, for a net increase of 1,291. Employment expanded at 10,740 establishments and contracted at 10,083. Small businesses accounted for 5,292 openings and 4,168 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding West Virginia establishments added 68,231 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 56,524, for a net increase of 11,707 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 10,536 jobs, or 90.0 percent of that total.





Thousands of jobs



Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$358.1 million in loans to West Virginia businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 980 identified firms exported goods worth \$6.8 billion from West Virginia in 2022. Of those exporters, 735—or 75.0 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$3.2 billion, making up 47.3 percent of exports by identified firms.


