






Between March 2022 and March 2023, 22,229 Wisconsin establishments opened and 16,971 closed, for a net increase of 5,258. Employment expanded at 43,077 establishments and contracted at 35,044. Small businesses accounted for 21,154 openings and 16,023 closings.

Employment

Opening and expanding Wisconsin establishments added 252,229 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 203,253, for a net increase of 48,976 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 44,224 jobs, or 90.3 percent of that total.







Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2022, reporting banks issued \$1.4 billion in loans to Wisconsin businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 


